Redevelopment of this blighted property was a huge catalyst for development in downtown Cincinnati.

Opened in 1912 as the five-star Metropole Hotel, the building was converted to low-income housing in 1971 and suffered from decades of neglect.

Today, the 21c Museum Hotel features 160 rooms, a restaurant/bar, a rooftop bar and an art gallery along with meeting and banquet space.

It was the first full-service hotel to open downtown in more than 25 years.
